AGS Conclave Safety Tips

Criminals are getting **smarter, bolder, and more violent every day**.
Be prepared to help keep our industry safe throughout tradeshow season.

WHILE ATTENDING AGS CONCLAVE:

- **Know Before You Go:** [Visit the Clarity Blog](#) to learn everything you need to know about pre, during, and post-show security.
- **Badge Security:** Wear your badge during the event but **remove** when you leave the show floor. After the event, **destroy** your badge by shredding or cutting it to prevent unauthorized use.
- **Be Aware of Your Surroundings:** Pay attention to exits, keep valuables close to your body and be conscious of who is in earshot of your conversations. Report any suspicious activity to security personnel immediately.
- **Insurance:** Be sure all merchandise and personal valuables are covered – talk to your trusted agent about your specific coverage limits before you go.
- **Booth Safety:** Always have more than one trained associate available for set-up, take-down and working during show hours. Never leave your booth unattended during show hours.
- **On-site Jewelry Handling:** Provide one-on-one attention to each customer and show only one item at a time. All merchandise should be controlled behind lockable cases if not being actively shown.

PROTECT YOUR STAFF AND STORE WHILE YOU'RE AWAY:

- **Suspicious Activity:** Respond to all alarms immediately and log, record, and report all suspicious activity to local law enforcement.
- **Emergency Communication:** Establish a clear protocol for staff to reach you while traveling. Identify a contact in your store, not attending Conclave, to check in with daily.
- **Security Measures:** Test your alarm system, motion detectors and cameras before leaving. Consider an [Interactive Video Detection System](#) for live monitoring on your phone.
